THE CHAIRMAN: 1 Aye. 2 Communications. 3 MS. GILMORE: None. THE CHAIRMAN: Was that none? 4 MS. GILMORE: None. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: Executive Director's 6 7 report. DIRECTOR LUCAS: Copies of the minutes 8 of the meeting on November 4, 2019 were mailed to 9 all Commissioners, Counsel Manfredi and the 10 Mayor's office. 11 12 Cycle painting is going extremely well. The Kingsland Court Apartments should be 13 14 completed by the second week of December. They 15 will be continuing with hallway painting in both 16 complexes afterwards. So the meat and potatoes 17 of the apartments will be finished. 18 We had placed an advertisement for bids 19 for the pavement replacement in the Harrison 20 Gardens and Kingsland Court. We received three 21 bids, which will be discussed at our next meeting 22 in January. 23 We also placed requests for a proposal 24 for architectural and engineering services

regarding the electrical upgrades, and we have

received three proposals. We are recommending to the Board that we use LAN, our engineering firm. They do have a guy named Bill Hodges. I made calls all around the State of New Jersey. He is supposedly -- and, you know, I hate using this word -- but the guru when it comes to our electric problems that we have here. We've come up with a plan, so, you know, we have that at the end of the motion, that's who we're recommending for the Board.

The draft of the five-year annual plan has been completed, and is consistent with the Hudson County plan pursuant to the HUD rules and regulations. We have the plan available for review in our office for the public. The hearing has been scheduled for January 10th at 2 p.m. We have forwarded a copy of the plan to the Board.

At our January meeting we will have the necessary resolutions for the Board's execution regarding submission of the five-year plan to HUD for their final approval.

Kelli Matthewson, our tenant activity coordinator, our new one, has scheduled a visit with Santa Claus for the children at the Housing Authority Saturday, December 14th. You guys are

1	all invited to come, if you'd like. It's from 11
2	o'clock to 1 o'clock. I will definitely be
3	there. She has planned to do crafts, coloring
4	and provide some light refreshments. Santa will
5	be in attendance to give each child a Christmas
6	present no matter how many children show up or
7	how many don't. Commissioners, you're more than
8	welcome to come, and our Christmas party has been
9	scheduled for this Friday at Ah Pizz from 2 to 5,
10	so I hope to see all the Commissioners there as
11	well.

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1 pipe work and all that other stuff, he did it by 2 hand. We also had one of our in maintenance 3 4 men come in and put a plow on, Michael Kearny, 5 without even being asked to do so. So the guys are doing a fantastic job, and I just want the 6 Board to know that. 7 THE CHAIRMAN: Great. 8 9 Motion to accept the maintenance 10 report? 9	will all be done, though, before the kids get out
10	of school. I promise you that.
11	THE CHAIRMAN: I need a motion to
12	approve the Resolution 1430-12-19 adopting the
13	2020 schedule.
14	COMMISSIONER CONFESSORE: Motion.
15	COMMISSIONER KINSELLA: Second.
16	THE CHAIRMAN: Okay. Motion made and
17	seconded.
18	Clerk, call the roll.
19	COMMISSIONER MILLER: Can I ask a
20	question about the two in July and August?
21	THE CHAIRMAN: Sure, go ahead.
22	COMMISSIONER MILLER: When you say
23	do I put them in my calendar as soft dates, or do
24	we tend not to have meetings in the summer?
25	THE CHAIRMAN: Usually we tend not to,

1	especially since the first or second week tend to
2	be around the 4th, and we tend not to enjoy, but
3	if we need one, we'll call one. So we'll usually
4	have plenty of notice.
5	DIRECTOR LUCAS: Usually the last one
6	we have in the summer is June because everyone's
7	still around.

3	for architectural and engineering services,
4	that's what Ray spoke about earlier for the
5	electrical.

2	adjudgments based on the recommendation of the
3	Executive Director, recommended by the Personnel
4	Committee.
5	MR. MANFREDI: So the recommendation is
6	for Michael Kearny to be elevated one step to
7	Senior Maintenance Repair, and Step 4 in that
8	category, which will bring him to 65,659.92 from
9	58,455.
10	The other adjustment is a 2 percent
11	increase for Joanne Romano as file clerk from
12	43,839 for an additional \$847.
13	THE CHAIRMAN: I would probably, if
14	anyone needs to discuss it, first make a motion
15	to go into closed session.

17	THE CHAIRMAN: Okay. So recommend?
