17	Pharmacy Plus. They came in and did something	
18	for our seniors, which was pretty awesome. They	
19	would like to hold a new program, a senior and	
20	disabled program here at the Gardens. They	
21	explained some of the highlights in the letter	
22	which I had sent to you, which is included in	
23	your thing: Blood pressure monitoring, glucose	
24	monitoring, blister pack dispensing, medication	
25	packaging. Tenants that are homebound can	

receive a complete medication review wherein the pharmacist will visit the patient's home to go over their medication. They came here, they had food. We had a lot of seniors that turned out.

I was in contact with Joanie Woods, we're going to be doing some other things together with Pharmacy Plus. It was pretty awesome for our seniors.

THE CHAIRMAN: Good.

DIRECTOR LUCAS: We also got a letter from the DCA approving Richard Miller as one of our Commissioners, which was all sent to everybody.

THE CHAIRMAN: He wasn't able to make tonight's meeting, he's out of the country. I spoke to him this afternoon.

Okay. Executive Director's report?

DIRECTOR LUCAS: We had the tenant

barbecue on June 26th, which everybody knows was
a great success. It was awesome, all the police

came, the fire truck came, it was great.

Tree service. The trimming job, they were fantastic, that is done. The top gutter cleansing, it has cleaned the gutter on both sides, that's also finished.

We have closed out the plumbing upgrades project in the Kingsland Courts site.

That's all done, check has been paid, that's off our plate as well.

The repaving bid has been placed in the Star Ledger and is returnable on October 29th. I will keep you updated on the process. We do have an end date for this project to be done June 3rd so our kids will not be affected in any single way as far as the summertime comes.

Cycle painting has begun inside the

Harrison Gardens, which is going extremely well.

And, also, we had some things with the boiler

system going on. I got some quotes for that

boiler system. It is under the threshold, the

bid threshold, which we will be awarding to the

company that sent us the thing. It's basically

\$9,800.

There's three projects that have to be done. Because of the time in September I don't want it to get any further waiting for quotes from anybody else, so we will be approving that for our boilers, for the guys to come in and fix the boilers. But because we awarded all three jobs to the same company we'll also get a 3

- percent discount, so that number will change once
 we get everything done.
