- 23 | for the 2023 grant it's \$1,024,965. So we got 1
- 24 | million two years in a row, Dr. Doran.
- 25 THE CHAIRMAN: Good. Good job.

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Okay. The storm doors are for the...? 1 2. DIRECTOR LUCAS: Outside, Dr. Doran, 3 when you initially walk up to the walk-ins, the highrises and stuff. They're all beat to hell, 4 5 so we wanted to get rid of those. We only had one bidder on the first go-around, and it was 6 astronomically high, so we rejected the bid. Rebid it, got the right number. 8 9 And then the cameras are brand new. 10 It's about 603,000. We had the RFP sent out 11 maybe a couple weeks ago. We got the bids in 12 yesterday. We selected the best, the lowest 13 price with the actual, they did the RFP 100 14 hundred percent correct. So \$604,453.92. So we 15 got the right one. And that's all state of the 16 art pixels, cameras. You'll be able to see 17 everything. 18 The only thing we didn't get, Dr. 19 Doran, I just want to make the Commissioners 20 aware, we didn't get the license plate reader 21 because we have to have a history of license 2.2 plates in our system, which we don't have. So it was irrelevant. 23 2.4 THE CHAIRMAN: Okay. Do I have a
